

# SUPERCHARGING

COME WHEN CALLED

*Dog*kind



Every dog needs to come when called reliably! Coming when called keeps your pup safer, and gives them the freedom to enjoy off-leash activities. Start your training out right by supercharging a brand new cue.

## WHAT YOU NEED TO GET STARTED:



Special food that your dog has never had before. Think cheese, chicken, steak, hotdogs, etc.



A NEW, special word or sound that will be your dog's new cue to come to you.

## FOLLOW THESE STEPS FOR A SUPERCHARGED RECALL CUE!



Prepare treats ahead of time, seal them in a baggie and hide them in your pocket.

When your dog isn't paying attention to you, say your new cue, just ONCE.



Pause for 2-3 seconds. Your treats should still be hidden! No reaching for them yet.

Time for a Treat Party!!! No matter what your dog did, make 10 treats rain from the sky.



Wait a few minutes, or even hours. Then repeat when your dog isn't paying attention to you.

When your dog is hurrying to you when they hear the new cue, start calling your dog from short distances, indoors.



- Add difficulty slowly, and practice and reward easy recalls often.
- Never ever call your dog and then scold them, or do something they dislike.
